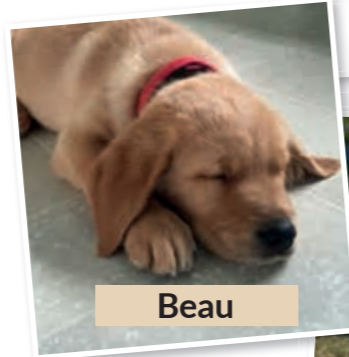

Medical Alert Assistance Dogs

At eight weeks old carefully chosen puppies go to live in homes with volunteers who help to socialise them. At a year old they are taught to help people with conditions such as diabetes.

Read about Archie, a seven-year-old, and how his Medical Alert Assistance Dog Domino helps him.



Hi, my name is Archie. I am seven years old and I have Type 1 diabetes.



I sometimes have to have an injection or eat sugary food to stop me from becoming very poorly.



I am Archie's Diabetes Alert Dog Domino. I can sniff and tell when he needs to have an injection or eat sugary food.



I stare at him to let him know and as a reward I get a yummy treat.



I follow Archie everywhere and because I have a clever nose I can smell when he isn't very well.



Domino is my best buddy. He tells me when I'm not well and keeps me safe.
