This pack is full of ideas to help you plan your day and have fun in your festive best. Every pound raised really can help us to save and change lives.

Here's how you can get started:

1. Choose a date to dazzle in December

Whether you are wearing a jolly jumper, a seasonal suit or a t-shirt covered in tinsel be sure to pick a date where the biggest number of people can join in. Festive Fridays are often best for fun activities but think about the people you want to join in and the best day for them.

Next you need to spread the cheer!

2. Spread the Cheer

We need your help to spread the festive cheer whilst raising money for a good cause.

- Put up the posters from your pack
- Send save the dates for your Festive Best Day
- Post about the day on social media
- Add the event to your email signature
- Remember you may need to remind guests 2 or 3 times about your plans so make sure to send regular reminders about your event.

3. Put on your Festive Best

Be creative. This is your opportunity to go as crazy as you would like. You can wear anything from your favourite festive fancy dress to simply putting on your jolliest jumper.

Don't have a Christmas outfit to hand? There is no need to splash the cash on a new outfit. Why not create your own festive masterpiece by adding some baubles or tinsel to an existing outfit.

Don't forget to get a picture of everyone together and share it on social media.

4. Raise Money

Collect £2 for everyone wearing their festive outfit (and why not fine the bah-humbugs for not wearing theirs and get £2 from them too.)

This pack also has ideas on activities you can do on the day to help raise a little extra. Every £ you raise will help us to train more dogs to save and change lives.



Fundraising Ideas

Turn your day into one big festive fundraiser with some of these ideas!

Bah Humbug

Don't let anyone be left out of the Festive Fun. Collect fines from the bah-humbug in the office!

Festive Bake Sale

Get everyone to bake something festive (or purchase shop brought goodies for those who don't like cooking) and sell them to raise even more funds for Medical Detection Dogs.

Sponsor a friend or colleague to wear the worst outfit

Why not raise some extra funds by paying £1 to nominate a friend or colleague to wear the worst outfit that you can find. Get your office or school to vote from all of the nominations.

Once you have a winner you need to choose two or more of the worst outfits you can find and display them in advance with collection tins. The outfit with the most donations wins. The only way the person can get out of wearing it is if they make a larger donation than the winning outfit accumulated.

Christmas Cards
