Jade and Jules



As a teenager, Jade began to suffer unpredictable faints, often injuring herself. Secondary school was plagued by absence, and she ended up having to try to teach herself from subject notes. "I couldn't go on school trips without family members going with me. I didn't get to go out with friends or do the typical things teenagers do. I went years without going to shops or cafes. I didn't even know how to use a contactless payment card until recently," says Jade.

After achieving the grades, she needed to study veterinary medicine at university, Jade decided to follow her dream and move away from home, hoping a fresh start. But Jade says; "It became very scary when I was getting injured alone in university accommodation with no family nearby and being unable to tell someone. I frequently had ambulance call outs for head related concussions, cuts, and black eyes."

Heartbreakingly, she decided to take some time out of university and life became limited to her family home. She didn't go out for months and even within the home she had to crawl along the floor to try to avoid injuring herself in a collapse. "I completely lost all independence, and my dream university course. I felt I had lost all my hope for the future," she says.

Her life has now been transformed by Fox red Labrador, Jules. Back at university, Jade knows Jules will alert her 2-5 minutes before an episode,



allowing her to sit or lie down. She says: "He has made a huge difference to my life. I can work on off-site practical's and concentrate in labs. He is the brightest golden ray of light and has completely lit up my whole world. I know he has everything under control."
