Medical Detection Dogs – Dogs Saving lives

Medical Detection Dogs trains dogs to detect the odour of human disease with the aim of developing faster, more efficient and less invasive diagnostics that lead to better patient outcomes.

We are at the forefront of the research into the fight against cancer and other life-threatening diseases, including Parkinson's disease and bacterial infections.

Our Bio Detection Dogs are trained to find the odour of those diseases in samples such as urine, breath and sweat and our work has the potential to benefit millions.

We already apply what we know about the science of canine olfaction to benefit people by training Medical Alert Assistance Dogs to detect minute changes in an individual's personal odour triggered by their disease and alert them to an impending medical event. This helps them manage complex, life-threatening medical conditions such as Postural Orthostatic Tachycardia Syndrome (PoTS), severe allergies, Addison's disease or Type 1 Diabetes and therefore drastically improve their quality of life.

We could not carry out our work training our incredible dogs without the generous support we receive from our supporters. Each time a dog alerts a client and prevents a medical emergency or identifies a positive sample of cancer or Parkinson's disease it is thanks to support from generous people like you, which ensures we can continue to train our life-saving dogs, thank you so much.
